


Quick Start Guide

Please follow the instructions below to ensure test day readiness for your ProProctor Live exam with Second Camera.




Placement

Place your smartphone about two arm lengths away to capture your desk/table surface and surroundings.



Stabilize

Make sure your smartphone is attached to a tripod or positioned on a stable surface, so it won't slip or tip over and block the camera.



Power

Make sure your smartphone is plugged into an outlet if you're not using an external battery.



Field of View

Position your smartphone to the side of your testing area to capture a wider view of your work area. Ensure your laptop/PC screen is not visible in the camera view.



Important

To avoid encountering any potential connection issues, please ensure you stay connected to the internet and the connection remains strong.


Check Your Smartphone

Please Note

Ensure the smartphone is set about two arm lengths away, connected to power, placed in landscape orientation, attached to a tripod or positioned on a stable surface and in an appropriate position within the room.





DEVICE

Needs to be a smartphone.



CAMERA

Needs to have a front facing camera.



SILENT

Ensure you can enable "Do Not Disturb" mode on your smartphone



OPERATING SYSTEM

Ensure the smartphone is using iOS or android operating systems.



VERSION

Android version 9 and above.

iOS version 12 and above.



INTERNET

Ensure your smartphone remains connected to the internet.
